

The Great Library Baking Competition

Rules and Guidelines

Hello all! Here at the library we are so excited to be hosting the second annual Great Library Baking Competition!! This competition is a fun way for children and teens alike to show their love and passion for baking, all in the spirit of light-hearted competition!

This year our judging panel will be comprised of local community leaders and business owners, who just happen to have a love for delicious treats!

The top 3 bakers in each age group will be awarded prizes which have been generously donated by The Friends of Greenwood Library.

Rules:

There will be 3 different categories with different baked goods assigned:

Children: 5-8

Children will be required to make cookies. (parental help is allowed)

Kids: 9-12

Kids will be required to make dessert bars. (lemon bars, brownies, etc.)

Teens 13-18

Teens will be required to make a 3-layer cake.

Items to bake: Each category will have a different dish to prepare. These dishes can be modified and contestants can get as creative as they like, all the while staying within the guidelines of the item they are required to make. **(see below for category items)**

**Example: if a 3-layer cake is your requirement, you may make this as creative as you like, as long as it is still a 3-layer cake.*

Requirements: Contestants will be required to provide a recipe with directions of the item they baked.

Drop-off Time: *Baked goods must be dropped off by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25th 2019, to be considered for judging.*

Judging and Awards Ceremony: Judging will begin at 5:15 and last until approximately 5:45. When judging is completed, the room will open up for contestants and their families to taste the baked goods. Contestants will be asked to serve their baked goods.

At approximately 6:15 p.m., winners will be announced and prizes will be given.
